The County Judge thereupon announced that the motion had duly and lawfully carried and that the order had been duly and law-fully adopted. The order thus adopted follows:

On JUNE 21, 2011, Harris County Judge Ed Emmett signed an Order Declaring a Disaster and Restricting the Sale, Dispensing or Use of Fireworks in the Unincorporated areas of Harris County, a copy of which order, hereinafter called the "Local Disaster Declaration," being attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Pursuant to Texas Government Code § 418.(b), a declaration of local disaster may not be continued or renewed for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the political subdivision.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this court hereby consents to the extension of the Local Disaster Declaration until such time as it is terminated by order of the County Judge, and the Local Disaster Declaration is hereby so extended.
